The Village of Plymouth convened in Safety Committee on March 07, 2024 at 4:30PM in person. The following members and visitors present:

The following item were discussed.

Fire

It was moved by Mr. Cassidy and seconded by Mrs. Moore to go into executive session per 121.22 (G)(2)- Purchase of Property at 4:30PM.

Committee returned from executive session at 5:00PM.

Police

Mr. Cassidy stated he had a discussion with Chief Hintz about getting the cruisers back on a replacement rotation; he would like to see new cruisers purchased every 2-3 years. The problem is right now, it is hard to even get a vehicle. We have been waiting since 2020.

Mayor Fryman asked Chief Hintz if we will even be able to get a new one. Hintz responded, he is not sure, but we do not know without trying. Everyone agrees it would be easiest to stick with purchasing from Tim Lally Chevrolet since they are familiar with the state purchasing process.

It was decided to proceed with legislation on the purchase of a new police Tahoe, Hintz to confirm updated price. This should be presented at the upcoming council meeting on March 12.

Other items discussed:

Two Factor Authentication-

- Hintz received notice from Department of Justice, they are implementing a new two factor authentication procedure to log in. He is trying to get a cost but is guessing it may be somewhere around \$3,600. He is working with Shelby; we will ultimately follow their lead since we log in through theirs. Should take effect in Oct/Nov this year.

Staffing-

- Hintz says right now they are tight but surviving.
- Really lucky with the addition of Officer Rodriquez, he is working as many hours as possible.
- Currently one full-time officer is off on sick leave, hopefully she will be back in a couple weeks.
- When Shafer returns, Andrus plans on being off. He is trying to hold off till Shafer gets back.

Eclipse-

- As of now there will only be one officer on duty. Of course, that person can call additional people in if necessary.
- The main concern is traffic going through town. The FD will have an additional two people on station.

It was decided to meet again the first part of April to see where we are with everything discussed today.
