Mrs. Jackson stated she was running for the position of Richland County Recorder unopposed this fall. She started in October of 2023. Jackson spoke of the duties of the Recorder and the office. Jackson stated there has been an increase in title theft. They are no longer accepting electronic paperwork. The Recorder's office has provided an online notification system called "FraudSleuth", to notify you if a record has been filed under your name.






