AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT A CREDIT CARD USE POLICY, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, R.C. 717.31 requires the Village to adopt a written Credit Card Use Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Village Credit Card Use Policy, attached to this Ordinance and as reviewed and approved by Council, is adopted.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to comply with R.C. 717.31 and its compliance deadline of February 2, 2019, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
