Motion: to confirm Brentan Ryman

Motion confirms and sets the hourly rate for Brentan Ryman as a full time Utility Worker upon successful drug test and physical.

Motion: transfer \$28,888 to Fund 4903 Street paving capital outlay

Motion is to transfer the money received so far for the harvesting of timber signed by McKay Hardwoods. The rest will be paid once they have harvested the trees.

Motion: Confirm Roub and Madden Fire/EMT

Mrs. Root stated she is working with Jarred on the disc golf. Also, if we have the funding she would like to get a double bench swing.


Discussion took place on the type of mulch that we should use. It was asked to look into the rubber mulch and get a quote.
