A RESOLUTION APPOINTING REBEKAH FEARING AS THE DESIGNEE FOR ALL ELECTED VILLAGE OFFICIALS FOR ANNUAL PUBLIC RECORDS TRAINING REQUIRED UNDER O.R.C. 109.43 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has determined to appoint a successor designee for annual Public Records Training.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT commencing March 13, 2019, Rebekah Fearing is appointed as the designee for all elected Village officials to receive all required annual Public Records Training required by O.R.C. 109.43.
2. THAT Rebekah Fearing shall complete the required Public Records Training as certified by the Ohio Attorney General.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to no longer require the Fiscal Officer to be responsible for this designation, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
