A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT REBEKAH FEARING AS THE SUCCESSOR VILLAGE PUBLIC RECORDS MANAGER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Rebekah Fearing has been designated as the designee for all elected Village Officials for Annual Public Records Training required under O.R.C. 109.43 and,

WHEREAS, she has received and will be receiving additional Ohio Public Records Training and,

WHEREAS, Council desires to reduce the time requirements placed on the Fiscal Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT Rebekah Fearing is appointed the Village Public Records Manager immediately upon her receipt of State of Ohio Certification of her completion of 2019 Public Records Training required under O.R.C. 109.43.
2. THAT Rebekah Fearing is appointed and designated as the Successor Village Records Manager to Diann Jamerson, the Village Fiscal Officer..
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to no longer require the Fiscal Officer to be responsible for this designation, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
