

Ordinance 11-2019

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 53.40(E) OF THE PLYMOUTH CODIFIED ORDINANCES BY INCREASING SEWER TAP FEES TO ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there is a necessity to increase the amount of sewer tap fees to cover the increased cost of sewer connections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 53.40(E) of the Plymouth Codified Ordinances is amended and reads as follows:

(E) Water tap fees are \$600.00 each and sewer tap fees are \$1,000.00 each.

Section 2. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to cover the Village's increased costs of providing sewer connections and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
