Julie Walcoff presented Plymouth-Shiloh School travel plan (safe routes to school).

A copy of her presentation is attached.

She went over the infrastructure prioritization, which was safety, use, connectivity and equity. She reviewed the project timeline. The project would not start until 2025. The funding is coming from Ohio Department of Transportation, they received federal funding for this program. The application is due by March 2022. Richland County Regional Planning is taking the lead on this project.

Mrs. Moore asked if the Village of Plymouth is financially responsible for the program. Julie stated the Funding will be coming from ODOT and we could get help from Richland County Regional Planning Commission.

Mrs. Felver wanted to know how we get the homeowner's permission. It was stated we wouldn't need much land and the Village or township has an easement or right-a-way.

It was asked what the next steps were.

Julie stated it would be to draft the plan for ODOT. There will be more information to follow.

**Water Rates**

Tonight will be the third and final reading on the water rates. It will be effective February 1, 2022, which is the billing for December.

**Amending Permanent Appropriations**

The Fiscal Officer stated this is to finalize the appropriations for the end of the year.

**Ambulance Mutual Aid**

Life First will be replacing Crawford Joint Ambulance District (CJAD). They are located in Sulphur Springs.

**Transfer to Street paving fund**

This is to move the money the Village received for the timber. They will be back in 2022 to clean up the area.

**Transformer agreement**


President Pro-Tem Root stated it would be best to wait on this until Mr. Patrick reviewed it so he could be part of the decision-making process.
