A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO THE CLIENT SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH MEDICOUNT MANAGEMENT, INC. FOR THE VILLAGE'S EMS BILLING SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized and directed to enter into the 2019 Client Services Agreement with Medicount Management, Inc. to provide and perform the Village's EMS billing services as reviewed and approved by Council.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to recover Village EMS operational costs by using EMS billing services, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
