A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE HURON COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into the Emergency Management Service Agreement with the Huron County Emergency Management Agency for the term from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2019 at the cost of \$464.25.
2. That Richard Metzger, 48 W. Broadway Street, Plymouth, Ohio (419) 687-5101, shall serve on behalf of the Village on the Huron County Emergency Management Advisory Board effective July 1, 2019.
3. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to continue the emergency management services with Huron County Emergency Management Agency, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
