

Ordinance 17-2019
Passed November 12, 2019

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE STREET PAVING CAPITAL PROJECT FUND ACCOUNT #4903 AND TO PROVIDE FOR ITS FUNDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in order for the Village to become competitive for grants for street improvements, it is necessary that funds be set aside for street paving projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT Village Fund #4903, to be known as the Street Paving Capital Project Fund, is established.
2. THAT Village Fund #4903 shall be funded from earned interest commencing September 1, 2019 on the Village's Civista Bank money market certificate, except interest earned by the Fire Equipment Levy, Resolution 19-2011.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to commence funding of the account in 2019, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
