

RESOLUTION NO. 20-2019

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A THREE (3) YEAR CONTRACT WITH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE C.B.& S. JOINT FIRE DISTRICT TO PROVIDE EMS/PARAMEDIC COVERAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, FROM TIME TO TIME THE VILLAGE FIRE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES MUTUAL ASSISTANCE TO COVER CALLS FOR EMS/PARAMEDIC SQUAD CALLS,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Village Fiscal Officer are authorized and directed to enter into a contract and agreement for additional EMS/Paramedic Protection with the Board of Trustees of the C.B. & S. Fire District for a term of three (3) years as reviewed and approved by Council.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to provide for additional emergency EMS/Paramedic coverage for the public safety and welfare by these services in less than thirty (30) days, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
