A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CONSUMER DRIVEN ADMINISTRATORS, LLC FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A FLEXIBLE SPENDING ACCOUNT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized and directed to enter into a Flexible Spending Account (FSA) with Consumer Driven Administrators, LLC as reviewed and approved by Council.
2. That the Fiscal Officer's prior actions in the establishment of the FSA for 2020 are approved.
3. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to complete the agreement within thirty (30) days, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
