A RESOLUTION TO AWARD THE PROFESSIONAL DESIGN SERVICES CONTRACT FOR THE WEST BROADWAY STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO GPD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has advertised for Professional Design Services for the West Broadway Street Improvement Project, and

WHEREAS, Council's review committee has made its recommendation to Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Professional Design Services contract for the West Broadway Street Improvement Project is approved with GPD according to the terms and conditions approved by Council.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to retain such Professional Design Services to enable the Village to seek OPWC funding, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
