A RESOLUTION TO CONFIRM THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF AUXILIARY POLICE OFFICER CHRISTOPHER ANDRUS TO THE POSITION OF PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor's appointment of auxiliary Police Officer Christopher Andrus to the position of part-time Police Officer is confirmed subject to his satisfactory completion of his six (6) month probationary period required by O.R.C. 737.17.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need for an additional part-time police officer to provide regular police protection in the Village, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
