A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE PLYMOUTH-SHILOH LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT TO PROVIDE A VILLAGE POLICE RESOURCE OFFICER DURING ALL STUDENT SCHOOL DAYS DURING THE 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor and Village Fiscal Officer are authorized to enter into a contract with the Board of Education of the Plymouth-Shiloh Local School District to provide a Village Police Resource Officer for all student school days during the 2019-2020 school year upon the payment of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00).
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate necessity to provide Police Resource Officers when needed, and this Resolution shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
