

RESOLUTION 29-2019

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO A THREE YEAR AGREEMENT FOR RESCUE AND AMBULANCE EMERGENCY SERVICES COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2020 WITH THE BOARD OF TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES OF NEW HAVEN TOWNSHIP, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized to enter into a three year agreement for rescue and ambulance emergency services commencing January 1, 2020 with the Board of Township Trustees of New Haven Township according to the terms and conditions approved by Council.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to provide uninterrupted emergency services commencing January 1, 2020 and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
