

Ordinance 4-2019
Passed February 12, 2019

AN ORDINANCE TO ENTER INTO A THIRTY (30) YEAR POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH EITRI FOUNDRY, LLC FOR IT TO DESIGN, BUILD, OPERATE, MAINTAIN AND OWN A SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEM FOR THE PURPOSE OF SELLING THE PRODUCED ELECTRICAL ENERGY THEREFROM TO THE VILLAGE AS A SUPPLEMENTAL ELECTRIC POWER SOURCE.

WHEREAS, providing a supplemental electric energy source to the Village's electric distribution will provide both financial and alternative power source benefits, and

WHEREAS, the Power Purchase Agreement does not require any expenditure of Village monies, and

WHEREAS, this Agreement provides for the use of solar energy as a viable energy alternative that is safe, environmentally friendly, and unlike any other alternative energy source now available to the Village for a cost limited solely on the actual electric energy generated and distributed to the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor, Village Fiscal Officer and Village Administrator are authorized and directed to enter into the thirty (30) year Power Purchase Agreement with Eitri Foundry, LLC which will provide supplemental solar-supplied electric energy to the Village's electric distribution system according to the Agreement's terms and conditions as reviewed and approved by Council.
2. THAT this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage.
