The Village of Plymouth convened in Pool/Park Committee on May 1, 2025 at 11:35AM in person. The following members and visitors were present:

Ms. Broderick called the meeting to order.

Park

Broderick stated the signs are being made. She will be doing the flowers once the signs are up.

Broderick asked that the wooden fence by the football field at the hill be repaired. There are some broken boards that need replaced. Also, the fence at the back of the tennis court needs repaired.

A quote was received to fix the tennis court. It was \$5,400 for fixing the bad spots, sealing and coating it. It was also stated we would need to buy new nets.

It was stated there is money available to do this project but it would limit other maintenance items such as repairs to the fences, new or repaired picnic tables, pavilion repairs, painting the walls and floors of the scout hut, buying the trash canister and bags for the dog park and any other unforeseen issues that need done.

Discussion took place on possibly just cleaning up the tennis court (pressure washing), re-line the courts and ordering the nets this year and repairing the court next year. It was decided to wait until next year to repair/reseal the tennis courts.

The FFA is to build 2 picnic tables. We would provide the supplies for them to make them. It was asked that one or two picnic tables be put over by the scout hut.

FFA work day will be the 19th of May.

Burton stated the driveway in front of the Scout hut needs to be deeper. He stated we have the gravel for it. We also need to paint the floors and walls in the scout hut.

At the ball court the pole has been fixed, backboards and rims are up. We have one new net and the benches are in.

Broderick asked if we had any more benches that could be repaired and moved over by the tennis court.

Items also suggested to be done were the following:

- Paint swing sets
- Replace the swings
- Replace the infant swings
- Add an infant swing by the scout hut
- Pressure wash the playground equipment

Broderick asked if the roof has been turned into insurance. Rebekah stated not yet. We need to look at the cost to repair before we submit a claim. It might not amount to enough to claim it.

Gazebo

Broderick asked if Dorothy would be doing the flowers. Burton to check with Dorothy Runkle. Broderick stated there is a board in the gazebo that needs replaced.

Veterans Park

Broderick stated she will check with Susan Moore to see if P.I.C. will be doing the flowers again this year.

A few other items mentioned were who would be mowing and spraying for weeds. A landscape timber needs to be moved back to the proper position, and the bushes around the fountain need to be trimmed.

Burton stated the fountain does have power. We need to take the top of the fountain off to repair the water lines. There are two of them. (An input and output line). They will be replaced with PEX line. He is hoping to have it done by Memorial Day.

Mr. Cassidy asked to make sure the service markers were cleaned off.

Dog Park

- Items are being moved
- A water line is being put in by the utility guys
- Will order the waste receptacles and bags

The dog park will probably not be ready until late fall or next spring. Broderick would like to see signs pointing to the dog park. It was also stated that these items can wait until after the pool is open.

Pool

Broderick stated the following:

- Pool is being drained and cleaned
- We do not have to replace the diving board
- Would like the deck(concrete) pressure washed and cleaned
- Caulk is being purchased and then completed.
- Burton has the additional space on the parking lot complete
- We are getting ready to order chemicals
- Hoping to paint next week it just depends on the weather.
- Need to weed eat inside and outside the fence around the pool.
- Need to get an update chlorine kit for pool
- Get phone connected
- We have the pretzel machine and need to order the microwave.

Opening day will be Memorial Day weekend (May 24th). Fees and rentals will remain the same as the 2024 season.

Wages were reviewed and legislation to be prepared for the May 13th meeting. Any new pool employee will be paid \$11.00 unless they have prior lifeguard experience.

Pioneer Rest Cemetery

Mr. Cassidy stated the Pioneer rest cemetery needs mowed. There are also a few headstones that need repaired. It was suggested to call Secor's or a monument company to find out appropriate steps. Also, the fence along the back of the cemetery on Railroad Street needs to be fixed.
