

Ordinance 5 - 2019

AN ORDINANCE TO ENTER INTO A MUNICIPAL POWER INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT FOR INTERCONNECTION AND PARALLEL OPERATION OF CERTIFIED INVERTER BASED EQUIPMENT FOR A THIRTY (30) YEAR TERM.

WHEREAS, Council has approved a Power Purchase Agreement with Eitri Foundry, LLC to supply supplemental solar generated electric energy to the Village, and

WHEREAS, the Village already has an established electric distribution system, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for Eitri Foundry, LLC to be able to connect its electric energy supply to the Village's electric distribution system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor, Village Fiscal Officer and Village Administrator are authorized and directed to enter into the thirty (30) year Municipal Power Interconnection Agreement for Interconnection and Parallel Operation of Certified Inverter Based Equipment with Eitri Foundry, LLC as it is necessary to make the Power Purchase Agreement practical and operational according to the Interconnection Agreement's terms and conditions as reviewed and approved by Council.
2. THAT this Agreement is to be signed only until and after the Village's signing of the Power Purchase Agreement with Eitri Foundry, LLC.
3. THAT this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage.
