Mr. Cassidy opened the meeting stating the legislation will be effective for Montel Gordon as the new Chief as of July 6, 2025.

Pay scale and rates were reviewed for the administrative chief position.

Mrs. Moore asked why the administrative chief is better than a patrolling chief.


Chief Hintz stated the administrative chief is better for multiple reasons. He listed them as follows:

1. Better for budgeting purposes.
2. If you were to do an hourly chief you are looking at a lot of overtime. This has happened in the past and the cost of the over time for just the chief alone was over \$20,000. This is not budget friendly nor is it easy to determine the amount of over time they may have.
3. If you work your chief on the road you need to be very careful that they do not exceed the hours set by federal wage and hour law. In the past this was not adhered to and we were audited and had to pay out thousands on top of penalty and interest.

Hintz recommended using the same language that was used when he was promoted to Chief.

Safety asked for an executive session to be on the agenda prior to legislation to inform council of their recommendation and answer any questions as to how their recommendation was determined.
