**Review of Legislation**

Council met to review the legislation for the meeting tonight.

**Motion - Confirmation of seasonal and part-time employees**

This motion is to confirm the appoint of the Pool personnel and the additional mowing personnel in the Village. The Administrator has hired a pool manager, assistant manager and currently three guards. There will be additional lifeguarda as soon as they pass the certification course. He also hired one employee to help with additional mowing around the town. Last year there were two seasonal employees helping with extra mowing. It was explain the Administrator has the authority to hire as long as there is a job description, pay range is provided and money has been appropriated. It is confirmed by council for verification purposes.

**Motion - Eitri Foundry, LLC.**

This motion is needed by Eitri bascially as a formality. It is stating that we are in good standing with the State of Ohio, we are not insolvent, we have a marketable title, not a foregin person, that there are no unrecorded deeds or liens on the property, no violations of covenants, and that there are no utility charges unpaid for the property.

**Resolution for Fire brush truck and Utility Vehicles**

This is for the second reading on a Resolution for the purchase of Village utility trucks and a skid attachment for the brush truck. Discussion took place on this in 2019.

**Resolution for Village Police Crusier.**

This is for the second reading on a Resolution for the repalcement of the Chevy Carprice Police crusier. This has been an ongoing discussion since last fall (2019). The letter of intent to purchase was signed and submitted.

**Resolution for a Renewal 6 mil General Levy**

This Resolution is for certifying the necessity of a RENEWAL tax of the current general levy. The monies used from this levy are for general operations and maintenance.

**Resolution for a Renewal 1 mil Park Levy**

This Resolution is for certifying the necessity of a RENEWAL tax of the current park levy. The monies used from this levy are for Park operations and maintenance.
