A RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THE QUESTION OF LEVYING AN ADDITIONAL TAX OF ONE QUARTER 0.025 MILL TAX FOR CURRENT EXPENSES FOR DEMOLITION OF BLIGHTED STRUCTURES IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 24th day of January, 2019, Council adopted a Resolution determining to submit to the Village electors a one-quarter mill 0.025 additional levy for Demolition of Blighted Structures in Excess of the Ten-Mill Limitation described below, a copy of which Resolution was certified to the County Auditor of Richland County; and

WHEREAS, the County Auditor has certified to this Board that the total current tax evaluation of Village of Plymouth is \$18,418,510.00 and the dollar amount of revenue that will be produced annually by the millage stated below would be \$4,604.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Plymouth, County of Richland, State of Ohio:

1. That this Council desires and determines to proceed with the submission to the electors of the question of levying a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Plymouth, Huron/Richland Counties, Ohio, for the purpose of current expenses for demolition of blighted structures in excess of the ten-mill limitation at a rate not exceeding one-quarter mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to two and one-half cents (\$0.025) for each one hundred dollars of valuation for five (5) years, and which levy is a renewal of an additional tax.
2. That the question of approving the renewal levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Plymouth at the general election to be held on the 7th day of May, 2019 and that said levy be placed on the tax lists of the 2019 tax year, first due in the calendar year 2020, in compliance with the provisions of O.R.C. 5705.34, if a majority of the electors voting therein vote in favor thereof.
3. That the Fiscal Officer of this Village is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Richland County, Ohio, not less than ninety days before the election, and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
4. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to provide for demolition and to timely file with the Board of Elections, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.

2. That the question of approving the additional levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Plymouth at the general election to be held on the 7th day of May, 2019 and that said levy be placed on the tax lists of the 2019 tax year, first due in the calendar year 2020, in compliance with the provisions of O.R.C. 5705.34, if a majority of the electors voting therein vote in favor thereof.
3. That the Fiscal Officer of this Village is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Richland County, Ohio, not less than ninety days before the election, and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
4. That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to provide for demolition and to timely file with the Board of Elections, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
