Resolution regarding Opioid claim



We could have a claim in the Purdue Pharma lawsuit. We are not liable for court cost. We are better to file if we do qualify for a claim.

Ordinance to remove fines and cost for minor marijuana violations

This Resolution is to change the penalty cost and fines for obtaining, possessing, cultivating, gifting, selling, and manufacturing marijuana or using marijuana paraphernalia to \$0.00, if it is under two hundred grams. It does not change the minor misdemeanor drug offense charge. Due to the cost of evidentiary testing requirements for the determination of marijuana THC or CBD .
