This Committee meeting was to discuss the reccomentation of the Finance committee to purchase a VacTruck.

Adminstrator Rusysnk reviewed information discussed in the Finance Committee.

- Quote AJV 1215, AJV610 for a Vac-truck.
 - Quote 1215 is for a 12 cubic yard /1500 gallon truck. Cost \$ 375,207.72
 - Quote AJV 610 is for a 6 cubic yard//1000gallon truck. Cost \$ 379,512.52
 - It could be used for cleaning of storm sewer, water leaks, hydro excavating, and electric pole setting.


Tim Banks stated this demo unit has only been used by the Village of Plymouth. If purchased it will come with the full warrenty. Besides the items previous listed it has the following:

- Has a lift capacity of up to 1000 lbs.
- He will provide training on the various uses and operation of the truck.
- He will also be our contact person for any questions or items needed.
- The (Vachall) portion was built in Ohio.

Mr. Banks answered a few questions of Council.

Mayor Fryman gave an update on the Hotel.

There was a meeting with the Richland County Land bank last Tuesday. The Engineers stated the Hotel is not sound and needs to be demolished. It was also stated the Bar is not structurally sound. The cost to demolish the Hotel could be anywhere from \$ 96,000 to \$ 185,000.
