Held January 24, 2023

Bids for West Broadway project.

This is just a formality in the process of the West Broadway street drainage improvement project.

Water/Sewer credit

This is to provide a credit to commercial and residential property located at 13 and 15 E. Main street, Plymouth, Ohio.

Discussion took place on the amount and the state statute.

Resolution: MARCS Grant

This is to accept the grant for \$360.00 for the year towards the monthly radio subscription for the MARCS radio.

Resolution: Contract with CB&S Joint fire district

A 3 year contract for additional EMS support when necessary. The price did increase. The Fiscal Officer stated the amount we paid for the year of 2022 went down compared to 2021.

Resolution: Hire 1 full time and 1 part time utility employee

This would be to hire a replacement for Jacob Fidler. It would also be to hire a part time employee.

Mrs. Moore asked if we should advertise it. The Fiscal Officer relayed what the Solicitor stated when he was asked this question. He had stated we should advertise the positions but with them being prior employees and due to the fact that we are short staffed we could bypass the advertising but not to make it a habit. Mrs. Moore also asked if we are creating a permanent part time position.

Mr. Patrick stated this is for a high school student who is in a work program. The Village used to hire kids part time. He feels this is a good program to use.

Mayor Fryman also asked if we were hiring a permanent part time employee.

Discussion took place over the hiring. Administrator Burton stated he needs the employees now.
