Mayor Fryman reviewed the following legislation for questions or discussion.

Legislation:

Res A: Authorizing satisfaction of Village mortgage

Fryman stated Optimax is selling the building and there were a few housekeeping items that needed to be cleaned up. The Village needs to provide a satisfaction of mortgage to the County Recorder.

Res B: Approve ODOT school flasher improvements on 603

Fryman stated this is for approval of school flasher improvements along State Route 603 in cooperation with ODOT. The project is currently scheduled for construction in the summer of 2024. The flashers will be located in front of the school.

Ord A: Amend Village income tax ordinance per House Bill 33

Fryman stated the State made some changes to the Ohio Revised Code regarding Income tax in House Bill 33. The Ordinance provides changes to our tax code to match the ORC.

Mrs. Moore asked what the acronym V.I.T.O. represented in the Legislation. The Fiscal Officer stated it is short for Village Income Tax Ordinance
