Committee before Council

Held May 9, 2023

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The Village of Plymouth convened in Committee on May 9, 2023 at 6:50PM in person. Mayor Fryman called the meeting to order with the following members and visitors present:

Mayor Fryman stated due to absent members tonight we will only be able to present three motions tonight. There are housekeeping matters, and will be reviewed briefly.

Pool Rates for 2023

The Fiscal Officer stated she had a question on the two highlighted items on the motion. They were as follows:

2. THAT the 2023 Group Pool Rental Rate per every two (2) hours shall be:

Groups less than fifty (50) (1 Manager/1 Guard)	\$100.00
Groups Fifty (50) or greater (1 Manager/2 Guards)	\$120.00
To provide open concession stand	\$10.00

5. That the 2023 one day Pool Rate with Park Rental:

For each person participating in a Park Rental the one day only	
Individual Pool Rate with Park Rental	\$2.00

These items were not discussed in the January Pool/Park committee meeting and was not sure if they should be removed or left in. A brief discussion took place and it was agreed to remove the highlighted areas prior to passage. It was also stated they would like to change the daily entry fee to the following:

1. THAT the 2023 Daily Individual Pool Rates shall be:

(a) 1 year and over	\$3.00
(b) Under 1 year	Free

The Fiscal Officer stated these would be changed before they signed the motion.


Mosquito Contract
