Review of Legislation


ODOT Ordinance – This gives permission for the Ohio Department of Transportation to come into the Village corporation limits while repaving State Route 61.

It was explained this is being done as an emergency because we received this last week from ODOT and they need it back by March 15, 2020. This will not cost us money it is just a formality.

Motion for Tahoe – This is being done as discussed in committee so that Tim Lally Chevrolet will hold the 2020 Tahoe until we have a chance to get legislation passed and financing completed to show the intent to purchase.

Chief Hintz stated the equipment for the cruiser was lowered and will be available to purchase with the cruiser. It was reduced down about \$3,000.

Motion to accept grant – This is to accept the Richland County Foundation grant for \$2,500 for beautification. It will specifically deal with a bike rack for the park and a tree, flowers and plaque at the point.
