Ordinance – To amend 32.022 Fire department

This will clean up the Ordinance from 1984. It corrects section A regarding the officers of the department.

Chief Metzger stated this is restructuring what we currently have. He is also recommending promoting 4 people currently on the department, partly because of Jeff Redden retiring.

Resolution – GovDeals

This allows the Village to advertise items for sale in the site. We do this at the beginning of every year. It was asked if we have anything to sell. The police department has some toner cartridges to sell.

Resolution – to Amend Resolution 27-2020

This is the second resolution that declares is a necessity to levy the real estate tax. This will put it on the ballot. The Council asked the Mayor to advertise this a few times.


Resolution – Sub Grant agreements

Administrator Rusynyk stated there was a person interested in renting the kitchen. Rebekah fearing stated that he has his own insurance and we are the secondary on the policy. Rusynyk stated he would maintain the equipment and would get prior approval if he uses the gym. There would be an extra charge for the gym use. He currently holds fundraisers and will soon be sponsoring a dinner in Shelby that is free for residents.
