Ms. Broderick stated Council will be doing a third reading on an a resolution tonight.

Mayor Fryman asked if there were any question over the legislation.

None were heard.

Chief Metzger stated he got the numbers back on the updated quotes. They are as follows:

#1 Life Line Superior Ambulance

- Purchase from PFUND Superior Sales
- Cost \$287,137.00- changed to \$306,116.
- Did not know credit
- Did not know if it would be a 2023 or 2024 Chassis

#2 Horton Ambulance

- Purchase from Horton Emergency Vehicles
- Cost \$318,935.00- No change
- Ohio dealer

#3 Braun Type 1 Chief XL

- Purchase from Penn Care
- Cost \$323,801.00- changed to \$333,606.
- Put in a \$16,600 buffer
- Cannot guarantee the rebate from the manufacturer.
- Also, an Ohio dealer

Ms. Broderick stated that Braun was thought the best bid, is made in Ohio and has a \$16,000.00 cushion.

Ms. Broderick asked the next steps.

Chief Metzger stated it would be to have legislation prepared for the next meeting. This is through the State purchase price. We are probably looking at twenty-four months for delivery. The money we put down will go into an interest-bearing account.

Ms. Broderick stated the sooner we do legislation we can earn interest and lock down the price. She stated to get the legislation for the next meeting.

Mr. Patrick stated could the price come down if the chips start being made, are we locked in at the price of \$333,000.00.

Chief Metzger stated the Chassis is a small portion of the truck. The equipment is the biggest cost. He does not see it going down in price. We wont really know the price until the VIN is issued.

Mr. Patrick stated his concern is if the price goes down are we locked into the higher price.

Chief Metzger stated the price is an estimate only.

Ms. Broderick stated the other quotes did not have a cushion.

Chief Metzger stated until it is made.

Chief Metzger stated he was not sure.

Discussion took place on the VIN. It was stated that once issued the process is starting.

Chief Metzger stated the control board finally came in for the furnace at the firehouse, but the heat exchanger is broke. It will need to be replaced.

Mr. Patrick stated it should have a lifetime warranty. Chief Metzger stated it does not for commercial use. He is waiting on Adams Heating and Cooling to send him the quote.
