Mrs. Moore started the meeting by going over the legislation.

Motion: To set the 2022 Pool rates

- This is the annual motion to set the pool rates. They are the same as last year.

Motion: Pool Managers

- This is to confirm the Administrator's recommendation to appoint Lisa Wilcox-Yarger and Darlene Gayheart as co-managers pending background check, drug test, physical and lifeguard certification. It was stated the managers being certified as lifeguards was good and would be very helpful incase we are short lifeguards.

Resolution: Safe Routes to School

- Village agrees to maintain the sidewalks along St. Rt. 603 per the Plymouth Codified Ordinances. If the project is awarded it would then be handed over to the Village to Administer. Administrator Burton will be the point of contact of the project administration and the Fiscal Officer will be the point of contact for the financial aspects of the project.

Ordinance: 2022 Annual appropriations

- To set the annual appropriations for the Village for 2022.

Ordinance: To adopt the S-11 supplement to the Codified Ordinances.

- To adopt and approve the S-11 supplement to the Village ordinances through June of 2021

Ordinance: To establish food truck & Mobile food unit parking zone

- Second reading to establish designated parking zones.

Ordinance: Establishing a food court zone at the location of the non-established parking area

- To establish food court zone (1) in the square not designated as parking in the triangle.

It was asked if it allows for a food truck and a non-food truck unit. Mr. Patrick stated there were changes made that made the size bigger and allowed for one food truck or two non-food truck.

Ordinance: Establishing Food zones (2 & 3)

- To establish food zones 2 and 3 in a specific location on West Broadway.

There was a question asked if the residents would be notified in advance especially on the south side. It was stated they would be notified by the Police department or the Village Administrator.

Ordinance: Amend Plymouth codified Ordinance Chapter 110 by amending 110.01 by deleting 110.20.

- To remove 110.20. This does not remove the soliciting and peddling license.

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Motion to Move to Executive session


