The Administrator stated there was no actual written report because they have just been plowing snow and looking for water leaks.

Mr. Patrick stated he met with Village Roots owners and Plymouth Improvement Committee regarding events. The following is a summary of events they would like to plan:

- They would like to have food trucks every Saturday from 11am to 6pm.
- Farmers market also on Saturday

In addition, Village Roots would like a food truck on Saturday for special events. However, they would not need it on Saturday's if the food trucks were on Saturday.

Chief Metzger stated we only have three inspectors. Two of them work the same shift. The third one has his own business and he works on the weekend. He felt we needed to speak with the Fire Marshall's Office to get clarification on fire inspections.

Discussion took place on the Health Department inspections.

Mr. Patrick stated the committee also discussed raising the permit fee for food trucks to \$50.00 annually and a per inspection fee.

Safety – Mr. Cassidy asked if the Police Chief had anything to report. Chief Hintz stated he did not.

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Chief Metzger reported we received a \$900.00 Fire Marshall's training grant. Announcements for the equipment grant (pagers/helmets) should be soon.

It was asked if the new brush truck was in service yet, Chief Metzger stated is should be later this week. We are getting closer. There were just a few more things that need to be done.




