## VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH SPECIAL SESSION

The Village of Plymouth convened in Special session on June 1, 2021 at 6:03 pm at 48 West Broadway Plymouth, Ohio 44865. Mayor Fryman called the meeting to order with the following members and visitors present:

Mayor Fryman lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mrs. Felver went over the events of when the pool was going to be shut down and then it was decided with the help of Plymouth Improvement committee it would open. It was also discussed at the time that money to operate the pool would not come from the General fund.

The cost to run the pool is approximately \$30,000.00 per year. We need to find other means to fund the pool. How are we going to continue to fund this every year? It was suggested to put a levy on the ballot or send out a survey. It was also suggested to form a pool committee with council and members of the community.

All but \$13,000.00 to operate the pool this year will come from the general fund. We also need to replace all 5 filters at the pool. It will cost approximately \$10,000.00.

The plan is to reallocate money from the following in the general fund various line items to transfer out to the pool:

\$ 4,000.00 from auditing  
\$ 4,000.00 to 15,000.00 from leftover work at firehouse  
\$ 9,000.00 from council that was for ordinance codification  
Approximately \$13,000.00 from ARPA funds for loss of pool income due to covid.

We currently do not have a manager.

We have a quote for two types of filters. One is available within a week or two – TR 140. The other there is no anticipated shipdate – TR140C. There will be a few additional plumbing supplies needed for the approximate cost of \$1,500.00.

Mrs. Felver stated we need to find a way to generate on going funding for the pool.

Mrs. Root stated we need a strategic planning committee to help develop plans for projects and other big ticket items in the Village.

Mayor Fryman stated we need a committee made up of residence and council to look into ways the pool can be funded. A levy puts it in the hands of the residents as to how important it is to people in the community.

Ms. Broderick and Mr. Patrick volunteered to be on the pool committee.

There will be an emergency meeting on June 2, 2021 at 6:00pm.
