Resolution re: Emergency purchase of Dump Truck



A MOTION TO CONFIRM THE APPOINTMENT OF TERRY TOLLIVER JR. TO THE POSITIONS OF VOLUNTEER FIRE/EMT AND PART-TIME FIRE/EMT AND TO SET HIS HOURLY RATE PER PAY GRADE QUALIFICATIONS.

WHEREAS, there is an immediate need to fill the vacancy of Volunteer Fire/EMT and Part-time Fire/EMT.
