This meeting was called to go over the permanent appropriations

Mrs. Felver reviewed what comes out of the general fund. The items are as follow:
Police, Zoning, Council, Mayor, Mayor's Court, Fiscal Officer, Income Tax, Building, real estate fees, and auditing fees.

She also asked if all members present had taken the sunshine law and ethics classes. Fiscal Officer is to double check for certificates and then email the links to Council and Fire Chief.

Mrs. Felver pointed out that within the council line items we appropriate for codifying of our ordinances. The Fiscal Officer stated they should be done every year but due to the prior year cuts, they have not been done and it is very important that they be done this year.

Discussion took place on the Park and Pool grants from ODNR. Ms. Broderick stated that she received notification that we have received the \$125,000.00 pool grant. This was the second grant applied for through ODNR. The first one is to be for the park. Ms. Broderick also stated we should be able to open the pool this year.

Plymouth Improvement Committee still has approximately \$5,000.00 in the pool savings account. They will donate to the pool to help with opening costs.


Chief Metzger spoke on where things were at with part-time coverage. He stated he was looking ahead and made recommendations to Councilman Cassidy on an EMS Coordinator and Training Officer.

Chief Metzger also stated if there was additional funding from the Cares Act they have come up with a few items needed: Squad sanitizer and different furniture that can be better sanitized.

It was stated the Administrator is working on a grant for streets and storm sewer. He will be doing a low to moderate survey of West Broadway in the next couple of weeks.

It was agreed by members present that for council meetings, the Fiscal Officer would only print off the agenda and legislation for meetings. Everything will be emailed in the council packet but not everything will be printed off.
