CO-ED MUD VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT RULES

1. **ALL PLAYERS** must read these rules and sign the release form before playing.
2. Shoes must be worn at all times.
3. All low top shoes must be taped.
4. Coin flip will determine side to start game. At eleven points, teams will change sides for the remainder of the game.
5. **ALL REFEREE DECISIONS ARE FINAL.**
6. If line judges disagree, point will be replayed.
7. Ten player maximum on roster, seven players maximum on court, three must be female. All players can only be on 1 roster; **NO TEAM JUMPING**
8. Subs must rotate into the serving position ***and players must play respective spots.***
9. Three, one minute time-outs per game, only when in control of the ball.
10. May stand no further than center court to serve. Foot foul is side out.
11. Serve at referee's whistle only. **No overhand serves.**
12. Must stand out of bounds to serve. Server doesn't have to return to the court between consecutive serves, but may not keep the ball in play from behind the line.
13. **Mud throwing or adding mud to the ball WILL NOT be tolerated.**
14. No contact with the net or sliding under the net.
15. Body contact or other obvious infractions will not be tolerated or allowed.
16. Only players are allowed within 5 feet of the court.
17. 3 hits to return ball, no double hits by same player. If two players hit the ball at the same time, then either player may hit the ball again.
18. Every ball that hits the boundary line will be called in.
19. Net serve will result in other teams ball.
20. ***No grace period. 1st round times given and after that it is your responsibility to be at fire house and ready to play. BE EARLY!!!! NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!***
21. Games on Saturday, between 6 pm and 8 pm, may be delayed due to the parade.
22. All games will be rally scoring to 21. Must win by 2 points.
23. Knee pads are optional.
24. **The referees have the right to modify the rules if necessary.**
25. Failure to follow these rules will result in your team's disqualification.
26. Entry fee is not refundable.
27. Prize money will be determined on Saturday.
