

Ordinance 1-2023
Passed March 14, 2023

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE 17-2019 AND TO RESERVE FUNDS IN THE VILLAGE FUND 4903 AS THE WEST BROADWAY PAVING FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the funding of the West Broadway Paving Improvement is now fully funded, and

WHEREAS, Council will consider future paving projects and their designated funding, and

WHEREAS, Council now desires to reserve fund 4903 for the West Broadway Paving Improvement until project is complete

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT Ordinance 17-2019 is repealed.
2. THAT the Village's fund 4903 be reserved for the West Broadway paving project.
3. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to reallocate the Civista Bank Money Market Certificate interest, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
