

Ordinance 11-2018

AN ORDINANCE TO IMMEDIATELY REMOVE BILL HUDSON FROM HIS POSITION AS VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR WITHOUT CAUSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Bill Hudson is the Village Administrator and no longer serves at the pleasure of Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Bill Hudson is immediately removed from his position of Plymouth Village Administrator without cause pursuant to ORC 735.271 for he no longer serves at the pleasure of Council.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency legislation, which shall go into immediate effect and for the additional reason there is an immediate need to have a Village Administrator that does serve at the immediate needs of the Village in accordance with the pleasure of the Council or shall otherwise go into effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
