

Ordinance 12-2021
Passed April 27, 2021

AN ORDINANCE TO RETAIN JAMES M. SUHANIC AS THE VILLAGE'S CONSULTING FORESTER AND TO ADVERTISE FOR THE SALE OF CUT TIMBER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village owns approximately 262 trees suitable for timber harvest requiring the assistance of James M. Suhanic, Consulting Forester, and

WHEREAS, the sale of the cut timber requires advertising and sale to the highest bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT James M. Suhanic is retained as the Village's Consulting Forester for administering the sale of approximately 262 trees per the Timber Sale Administration Contract reviewed and approved by Council.
2. THAT the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are authorized to sign said Timber Sale Administration Contract.
3. THAT the Village Administrator is authorized and directed to advertise for the sale of the approximate 262 cut timber trees.
4. THAT a sale of such timber to the highest sealed bidder by the Mayor is authorized according to the approved Timber Sale bid requirements.
5. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to begin the sale of timber in order to obtain the best market price, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
