

Ordinance 15-2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE COMMITMENT OF \$324,832.00 FOR THE COMMUNITY BLOCK GRANT FUNDING OF WEST BROADWAY STREET STORMWATER INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there is a necessity to replace the existing West Broadway Street stormwater system, and


WHEREAS, CDBG funding is available to assist the Village for such a project improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the amount of \$324,832.00 is committed for the Village match for the 2021 Critical Infrastructure Program of the Community Development Block Grant Funding for the West Broadway Street stormwater infrastructure improvement project.
2. THAT the Mayor is authorized and directed to commit \$324,832.00 to the Village's match for the project cost and to approve and sign the 2021 Critical Infrastructure Condition Certification.
3. THAT the Mayor is authorized to make, sign and submit the necessary Grant Application for the Community Development Block Grant Project Funding with the assistance of the Executive Director of the Richland County Regional Planning Commission.
4. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the additional reason there is an immediate need to timely file for the 2021 CDBG funding and there is a necessity to complete the project as soon as possible, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.


