

Ordinance 2 - 2020

AN ORDINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ITS STATE ROUTE 61 PAVEMENT PROJECT INSIDE THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of this Ordinance the Project is described as follows:
To perform preventive maintenance, smoothseal, on multiple routes in Richland County. These routes include State Route 96 from the Shelby Corp Limit to State Route 13, and State Route 61 Shelby Corp Limit to a pavement joint just inside the Village of Plymouth.

Approximately 800 feet of this resurfacing is within the Village of Plymouth.

This project is currently scheduled to start construction in the fall of 2020 and finish construction in early summer of 2021

SECTION 2. Being in the public interest, the Village gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the project described in Section 1.

SECTION 3. The Village shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

- 1) The Village gives consent for the above improvement
- 2) No funds are required from the Village except that the Village agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the total cost for added construction items requested by the Village and not necessary for the improvement as determined by the State and the Federal Highway Administration.

SECTION 4. The Village will maintain the right-of-way and keep it free of obstructions, and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION 5. If Village owned utilities, within a corporation limit or in a private easement outside corporation limits, need to be relocated due to this ODOT project, the Village will be reimbursed for any relocation work; ODOT will perform the coordination, relocation, and reimbursement which shall comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION 6. The Village Administrator of said Village of Plymouth is hereby empowered on behalf of the Village of Plymouth to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

SECTION 7. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure to expedite the highway project and to promote highway safety and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
