

ORDINANCE NO. 23-2021
Passed October 26, 2021

AN ORDINANCE FINDING A REAL AND PRESENT EMERGENCY ARISING IN CONNECTION WITH THE OPERATION OF THE VILLAGE UTILITY DEPARTMENT DUE TO BOTH VILLAGE DUMP TRUCKS BEING OUT OF COMMISSION RESULTING IN THE FORESEEABLE INABILITY OF THE VILLAGE TO PROVIDE BASIC AND NECESSARY SERVICES SUCH AS LEAF PICKUP, SALTING OF ROADS AND PERFORMING CEMETERY AND STREET MAINTENANCE.

WHEREAS, the Village's only two dump trucks are out of commission, and

WHEREAS, without such trucks the Village utility department cannot perform basic services such as leaf pick up, salting of roads and performing cemetery and street maintenance, and

WHEREAS, the pending purchase of a new truck may require several months prior to delivery, and

WHEREAS, without an available dump truck a real and present emergency exists in the operation of the village utility department, and

WHEREAS, R.C. 735.051 with a two-thirds vote of council permits the Village Administrator to purchase a dump truck without formal bidding and advertising.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH,
STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Village Administrator is authorized to purchase a dump truck suitable for Village utility needs without formal bidding and advertising at a cost not exceeding \$80,000.00.

SECTION 2. That the purchase price for the truck shall be paid from such Village funds selected by the Village Fiscal Officer which may include the necessity of securing a loan.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the additional reason a real and present emergency exists due to the lack of a usable dump truck to perform necessary and basic utility services, and shall

therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
