

Ordinance 4-2021

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 154.180(B) OF THE PLYMOUTH CODIFIED ORDINANCES BY REMOVING THE RESIDENT ELECTION REQUIREMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR APPOINTMENT AT THE PLEASURE OF THE MAYOR OR COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT Section 154.180(B) of the Plymouth Codified Ordinances is amended and shall read as follows:

(B) The Mayor shall appoint the zoning inspector who need not be a resident of the Village. The zoning inspector shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor or Council.

2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency resolution necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to have a zoning inspector for pending Village land use applications and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
