

Ordinance 5-2023

AN ORDINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONSENT AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE REMOVAL AND CONTROL OF SNOW AND ICE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into the July 1, 2023 Consent Agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation for removal of snow and ice as reviewed and approved by Council.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to submit the ODOT Consent Agreement for timely renewal prior to the 2023/2024 winter season, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
