
AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF COVID SPECIAL FUNDING FROM SPECIAL REVENUE ACCOUNT #2904 TO SPECIAL REVENUE ACCOUNT #2151 AS DIRECTED BY THE OHIO AUDITOR OF STATE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, the Ohio Auditor of State has advised that COVID Special Funding received by the Village be held in Special Revenue Account #2151.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT the Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to transfer from Special Revenue Account #2904 to Special Revenue Account #2151 all COVID special funding received to date and thereafter deposit all such funding in Account #2151.
2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village and for the further reason that there is an immediate need to comply with the directive of the Ohio Auditor of State, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council, otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.


