

Ordinance 14-2018

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 34.03(B) OF THE PLYMOUTH CODIFIED ORDINANCE BY ESTABLISHING FORTY (40) HOURS PER CALENDAR WEEK AS THE STANDARD WORK WEEK FOR ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND APPLY THE VILLAGE'S PERSONNEL POLICY SECTION 3.02 FOR CALCULATING OVERTIME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT Section 34.03(B) of the Plymouth Codified Ordinance is amended commencing July 29, 2018 and shall read as follows:

The standard work week for all employees of the Village Police Department shall be forty (40) hours per calendar week and each employee shall be paid overtime in accordance with Section 3.02 of the Village Personnel and Procedure Manual.

2. THAT it is hereby determined that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this Village, for the additional reason that there is an immediate need to clarify the payment of overtime in keeping with the operations of the Village's Police Department, and this Ordinance shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
