

Ordinance 16-2018  
Passed August 14, 2018

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE UNNAMED ALLEY BETWEEN  
VILLAGE LOTS 288 AND 33.

WHEREAS, Village Council received a petition to vacate the alley between Lots 288 and 33;  
and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held July 24, 2018 with notice to adjoining lot owners; and

WHEREAS, no person has objected to the vacation of the alley.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF  
PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

1. THAT for the reason upon hearing and being satisfied, there is good cause to vacate the below-described alley and that the vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest, the following described alley is vacated:

Running east and perpendicular from Plymouth Street between Village Lots 288 and 33, a distance of 159.81 ± feet and having a width of ten (10) feet and being further described in EXHIBIT A, attached hereto.

2. THAT the Fiscal Officer shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Richland County Auditor and Recorder.
3. THAT this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
