

Ordinance 18-2018

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE CONNECTING ALLEYS OF (1) COMMENCING NORTH AT EAST HIGH STREET AND RUNNING BETWEEN LOTS 41 AND 48 AND (2) COMMENCING AT PADDOCK WAY AND RUNNING EASTERLY TO MULBERRY STREET BETWEEN LOTS 42, 41, 48 AND 47 TO ITS SOUTH AND LOTS 43, 44, AND 46 TO ITS NORTH.

WHEREAS, Council has conducted a public hearing on September 25, 2018, for the purpose of considering the petition of Rusty Taylor to close two connecting alleys, and

WHEREAS, Council finds there is good cause for the closing of the alleys and the closings would not be detrimental to general interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, COUNTY OF RICHLAND/HURON, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. THAT the below described connecting alleys as indicated on the tax map attached hereto as Exhibit A are vacated:

(1) The alley commencing at East High Street and running north between and the length Lots 41 and 48 and (2) the alley commencing at Paddock Way and running easterly to Mulberry Street and between Lots 42, 41, 48 and 47 to its south and Lots 43, 44 and 46 to its north.

SECTION 2. THAT the Fiscal Officer is directed to prepare a certified copy of this ordinance with Richland County plat records.

SECTION 3. THAT this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
