AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, OHIO TO MEET THE ORDINARY EXPENSES OF SAID VILLAGE UNDER AUTHORITY OF OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.38; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, this Council of the Village of Plymouth, Ohio, desires to postpone the passage of the annual appropriations pursuant to the authority granted by Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.38, and

Whereas, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to meet said ordinary expenses of said Village, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, OHIO, 6 members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated by this Council of the Village of Plymouth, Ohio, pursuant to the authority granted by Ohio revised Code Section 5705.38, as temporary appropriation measure, sufficient monies necessary to meet the ordinary expenses of said village until such time as the annual appropriations ordinance is passed, but not later than April 1, 2019.

Section 2. For the reason that is immediately necessary to meet said ordinary expenses of the said Village this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
